

## Car Seat Checklist: Getting Ready to Go Home

## **Babies Are at Greater Risk in Car Accidents**

Many injuries and deaths can be prevented with the right use of child car seats. As many as 80% to 90% of car seats are used incorrectly, so make sure you know how to install and use yours correctly.

Before My Baby Is Born	
	I am aware that it is my responsibility to know how to use and install the car seat.
	I have a rear-facing car seat purchased in Canada.
	I have checked the expiry date of the car seat.
	I have read and understand the car seat manual.
	I have taken the car seat out of the box and know how to install it in my car.
After My Baby Is Born	
	I will have a car seat present in my room at least 1 day prior to going home.
	I will check that all car seat parts are ready to use.
	I will bring the car seat manual to the hospital.
	I will bring extra blankets for support and covering baby.
	I will practice placing baby in the car seat before going home.
