At Home

Please give your child pain medication as follows:

- Follow each bottle's instructions and give both medications regularly.
- Give your child pain medication overnight to ensure continued comfort. This is especially important on the first night after surgery.
- Do not give ibuprofen regularly after 48 hours. If your child still needs ibuprofen after 48 hours or if you have concerns about the amount of pain your child experiences, please contact your child's surgeon.
- Give acetaminophen regularly for up to 5 days after the tonsillectomy.

 Ask your local pharmacist if you have any questions about your child's pain medication.

Eating & Drinking

At _____ your child can try a "full fluids" diet such as milk, yogurts, pudding, or ice cream.

- Avoid citrus fluids such as orange juice.
- It is okay if your child does not want to eat solid food for 1-2 days.
- It is important that your child is drinking fluids.
- Your child should pee more than twice a day and their urine should be pale yellow.
 Small amounts of pee and peeing less than twice a day are signs that your child needs to drink more fluids.

Nausea & Vomiting (Throwing up)

It is common for children to vomit in the car on their way home.

If your child vomis more than 3 times in the first 2-3 hours after going home, consider giving one dose of Gravol® (dimenhydrinate). Follow the directions on the package and ask your pharmacist.

Your child's surgeon will determine your child's follow up appointment.

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Contact your child's ENT surgeon's office at 604-875-2113 if:

- Your child's pain is not controlled by the suggested medication.
- Your child's nausea or vomiting continues after one dose of Gravol® (dimenhydrinate).
- Your child has a fever for more than 24 hours following surgery.
- Your child's breath is very unpleasant.
- You are worried about your child.
