

EpiPen

Instructions



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Use your prescribed device for severe allergic reactions:

- ▶ severe hives all over the body
- ▶ swelling (throat, tongue)
- ▶ difficulty swallowing
- ▶ difficulty breathing
- ▶ dizziness or fainting

If in doubt, give Epinephrine!

Remember:

A - Airway

B - Breathing

C - Circulation
(blood pressure)

D - If in Doubt

Immediately call 911 or seek medical help right away.

Proper dosing for the following devices:

- ▶ 0.15 mg (Junior) if child less than 20 kg in weight.
- ▶ 0.3 mg (Regular) if over 20-25 kg

Switch at 20 kg especially important if child has **asthma**

How to use the EpiPen Auto-Injector

Three simple steps:



1. Pull off the blue safety cap.

2. Push orange tip firmly into outer thigh until you hear a click.



3. Hold on thigh for several seconds.

When epipen is removed the orange needle cover automatically extends to cover the used needle.
