Who will I meet when I arrive at Sunny Hill?


The receptionist will meet you and help you out.

Where will I go when I get there?

The receptionist will let you know where your appointment will begin. You will meet people who work with children, like a children's doctor, a psychologist and maybe others. They will spend time with you and your family.

What will happen when I meet them?

The people will want to talk with you and your family. They will ask you questions and you can ask them questions. They might get you to do some activities, like drawing. Don't worry, the doctor won't give you a needle.

Can I take a break?

Yes. If you need a break, just ask someone. "Family Place" is a room where you and your family can go to take a break or have a snack. Bring a snack with you!
