

### From Tsawwassen ferry terminal

Exit becomes Hwy 17. Take Hwy 99 North ramp to Richmond/Vancouver. Merge onto Route 99 North. Take Exit 37 to Hwy 91 East then Knight Street Exit only to 33rd Ave. Turn right on 33rd Ave which turns into Slocan Street at Kingsway. Follow Slocan Street to Sunny Hill.

### From Vancouver International Airport

Airport exit becomes Grant McConachie Way. Grant McConachie Way becomes Arthur Laing Bridge leading into Vancouver. Stay on the left and exit onto South West Marine Drive. Go East on SW Marine Drive to the Knight Street North exit. Follow Knight Street to 33rd Avenue. Turn right on 33rd Ave which turns into Slocan Street at Kingsway. Follow Slocan Street to Sunny Hill.

### Is there public transit to Sunny Hill?

The Translink bus stops on Renfrew Street near 21st Avenue, and near 22nd Avenue and Slocan Street. The bus stop at 22nd and Slocan is wheelchair accessible, and closest to the hospital.

Sunny Hill has a cash-only cafeteria that offers lunch and snacks such as sandwiches, soup, and muffins. As well, we have some vending machines where you can buy snacks and drinks. ## What will happen at my child's assessment?

An assessment usually takes several hours over the course of the day. Sometimes the assessment may need to be scheduled over two days. Your child should wear running shoes and loose comfortable clothing to the assessment.

During the assessment, you will be asked about your child's development, strengths and areas of difficulty. You may want to bring a friend or relative with you as a support person.

Your child will be asked to complete some activities and tests, and will be observed while he or she plays. This will help the team understand how your child learns and is developing. If your child is scheduled to see the developmental pediatrician, a neurological and physical examination will also be scheduled. No medical investigations will be done at this time.

Sunny Hill is a teaching facility. There may be a student or trainee involved in your child's assessment.

## Are services available in languages other than English?

Yes. We will arrange for an interpreter to be present during your appointments if you need one. Please let us know if you need an interpreter.

## What should I bring to Sunny Hill?

Please bring:

- your child's BC care card
- your child's BC Children's Hospital blue card
- appointment letter
- list of any medications and the amounts that your child is taking
- notepaper and pen

To make the day go smoothly for your child, bring:

- snack
- activities for when your child has free time (book, colouring, etc.)
- anything that will put your child at ease (favourite toy, blanket, etc.)

It will help the team assess your child if you bring:

- notes from your observations of your child leading up to the visit
- any written comments you have from teachers, doctors, therapists, and others who know your child well
- copies of any recent formal assessments
- drawing and writing samples from your child
- a recent photograph of your child

## What should I leave at home?

### Scent-free

Sunny Hill is a scent-free environment for the benefit of our patients, families and staff. Please do not wear perfume or cologne.

### Valuables

Please do not bring any valuables with you to Sunny Hill. We are not responsible for lost or missing items.

### Non-medical drugs and alcohol

Absolutely no alcohol or non-medical drugs are allowed at Sunny Hill. If you are found with them, security services will escort you from the building.

## When do I hear about the results?

A family conference is scheduled once all assessments are completed. The team reviews your child's assessment findings and identifies strengths and areas where your child requires assistance. You and your community team will be asked to help develop a plan for your child.

You decide who attends the family conference. We can arrange for your child to be looked after during this meeting, but you will need to arrange for someone to look after any siblings that you decide to bring along. With advance notice we can also arrange a telephone conference with any community team members who are unable to attend the conference in person.

A report is prepared and sent to you and to any others you want to receive it. This may include your child's doctor, school or therapists.


## What happens after the assessment?

Your child's report will outline recommendations that will help your child at home, at school and in the community. Follow-up may also be recommended to see if there are any diagnoses that help to explain your child's difficulties. It is

up to you and your child's community team to implement the recommendations made in the report.

## Where is Sunny Hill?

We are at 3644 Slocan Street, Vancouver. Sunny Hill Health Centre is part of Children's and Women's Health Centre of British Columbia, but it is not located at the Children's Hospital.



### From BC's Children's Hospital

Take 33rd Ave East. It will turn into Slocan Street at Kingsway. Follow Slocan Street to Sunny Hill.

### From the East

Follow Highway 1 (the freeway or Trans Canada) to Grandview Highway (12th Avenue Exit). Follow Grandview Highway past Renfrew Street to Slocan Street and turn left up the hill to Sunny Hill.

### From Horseshoe Bay ferry terminal

Follow the freeway east across the 2nd Narrows Bridge. Take the McGill Street exit (right) to Renfrew Street, turn left and follow Renfrew to Grandview Highway (12th Ave). Turn Right. The second light is Slocan Street. Turn left and up the hill.
